

Rebels Volleyball Player Contract

This Player Contract sets the standard expectations for athletes and families participating on a Rebels Volleyball team. It is intended to confirm commitment, outline responsibilities, and provide a clear framework for the team season. This contract should be reviewed carefully by the player and parent or guardian before signing.

1. Term of Commitment

This agreement begins on the date it is signed and remains in effect for the full Rebels Volleyball season unless ended under the terms of this contract. The player and parent or guardian understand that club participation is a season-long commitment that includes practices, tournaments, required meetings, and other team activities communicated by the club.

2. Dues and Payment Obligations

The player and parent or guardian agree to pay all club dues, deposits, and other approved team costs by the deadlines established by Rebels Volleyball. Unless the club states otherwise in writing, financial commitments are not reduced because of missed practices, missed tournaments, injury, illness, schedule conflicts, or voluntary withdrawal after accepting a roster position. Any payment plan, late fee policy, or non-refundable deposit terms communicated by the club are part of this agreement.

3. Attendance and Participation

The player is expected to attend scheduled practices, tournaments, meetings, and team activities unless excused by the coaching staff or club leadership. Families should communicate known conflicts as early as possible. Repeated absences, late arrivals, or unexcused missed events may affect lineup decisions, role reliability, and overall standing within the team structure.

4. Conduct and Team Standards

The player agrees to demonstrate effort, coachability, respect, honesty, and sportsmanship at all team functions. The parent or guardian agrees to support the team positively, respect coaches, officials, teammates, opponents, and families, and avoid disruptive sideline behavior or inappropriate communications. Rebels Volleyball may impose consequences for behavior that undermines team culture, safety, or the integrity of the club.

5. Communication Expectations

Team communication will be distributed through the club's designated communication platform and official messaging channels. Families are responsible for reviewing updates promptly. Questions about player development, role, or concerns should follow the club's communication process, including a cooling-off period after competition when applicable. Players are encouraged to communicate directly with coaches first when age and maturity make that appropriate.

6. Playing Time and Team Roles

The player and parent or guardian understand that playing time in club volleyball is not guaranteed unless specifically stated by the club in writing. Coaches will make lineup and playing time decisions based on team needs, attendance, effort, skill execution, competitive readiness, positional balance, and other factors relevant to match performance and player development.

7. Travel and Tournament Participation

The player and family agree to support the team's published tournament schedule and understand that travel may be required for certain events. Families are responsible for transportation, lodging, meals, and other personal travel expenses unless the club states otherwise in writing. The player is expected to arrive on time, follow team travel expectations, and conduct herself responsibly at all tournament venues and related team activities.

8. Medical, Injury, and Safety

The parent or guardian agrees to provide accurate medical information, emergency contacts, and any required participation forms before the athlete participates. The player must report injuries, suspected concussion symptoms, illness, or other safety concerns immediately to the coaching staff. Rebels Volleyball may require medical clearance before a player returns to participation after an injury or other health-related absence.

9. Media and Publicity Acknowledgment

The player and parent or guardian understand that team-related photographs, video, or basic identifying information such as first name, jersey number, team name, and position may be used by Rebels Volleyball for ordinary club communications, schedules, results, and promotional materials, unless the family provides written notice of a restriction that the club can reasonably honor.

10. Withdrawal, Suspension, and Release

If a player chooses to withdraw after accepting a roster position, the family remains responsible for the financial obligations already incurred or committed by the club on the player's behalf unless the club agrees in writing. Rebels Volleyball may suspend or remove a player from participation for serious or repeated violations of team standards, nonpayment, safety issues, or conduct inconsistent with the club's mission and policies. Any release from the team or exception to financial obligations must be approved by the club in writing.

11. Acknowledgment and Signatures

By signing below, the player and parent or guardian acknowledge that they have read this contract, understand its expectations, and agree to comply with Rebels Volleyball team standards and policies.
